- Copy of official transcript of marks from previous year of school (final year of secondary school or previous year of post-secondary education, showing a minimum of 2 semesters and 10 courses). Minimum average grade achievement of 70% required (or equivalent letter or grade point average).
- Confirmation of acceptance to accredited Canadian post-secondary institution
- ½ to 1 page outline of student's career goals
- ½ to 1 page outline of student's community involvement and/or extra-curricular activities

Evaluation Criteria:

Scholarship applications will be evaluated on the following 100 point system:

60 points	Scholastic Achievement
20 points	Planning and Career Goals*
20 points	Community Involvement / Extra-Curricular Activities

* Career goals will be evaluated based on the student's plans to use their education to further their career goals, not on the actual position being sought.
