- Must be enrolled or enrolling full-time at an accredited Canadian College, University or Institute of Technology.
- Minimum average grade achievement of 70% or equivalent letter or grade point average.
- Member company must be in good standing with respect to payment of current year's dues.

Application

- Completed application form
- Copy of official transcript of marks from previous year of school (final year of secondary school or previous year of post-secondary education, **showing a minimum of 2 semesters and 10 courses**).
- Confirmation of acceptance to accredited Canadian post –secondary institution.
- 1 page outline of student's career goals.
- 1 page outline of student's community involvement and/or extra-curricular activities.

Evaluation

- Scholastic Achievement 60/100 points.
- Planning and Career Goals* 20/100 points.
- Community Involvement / Extra-Curricular Activities 20/100 points.

*Career goals will be evaluated based on the student's plans to use their education to further their career goals, not on the actual position being sought.
