

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Who do I call for a commercial vehicle permit?

Permits are handled by the Provincial Permit Centre at 1-800-559-9688. You may also apply for a permit online at the Commercial Vehicle Safety and Enforcement (CVSE) Branch Online Permits webpage at <http://www.th.gov.bc.ca/cvse/tps/>

2. Who do I contact if I have a question related to the National Safety Code (NSC)?
